

## Court assistance

- for victims -

Information in plain language.



Judges and public prosecutors may order court assistance. Court helpers will talk to you.



You can tell the court helper how you feel after the crime.

And what effects it has had on your life.

The court helper will then write a report.

They will write it in a neutral way.

This means that they do not

write down their own opinions.

The report will be included in the accused's (offender's) criminal file.



The report can also be used in the main trial.

Court helpers also provide information about counselling.

Working with court helpers is your choice.

If you not want to work with a court helper, this will not disadvantage you.


## **About us**
