WHAT WE BUILD ON

Our actions are based on treating all clients with respect. We stand for resocialization in the case of crime and promote the assumption of responsibility in order to enable clients to lead a crime-free life.

Criminal law stipulates that your circumstances must be taken into account at all times during criminal proceedings. For this reason, court assistance can be commissioned to report on your personality, your development and your life situation and, if necessary, to comment on suitable measures. The clients are the public prosecutor's office or the court, which are supported in their decision-making by the court assistance report.

The created report becomes part of the criminal file and can be included in the main hearing. We can also inform you about help and counselling services and victim-offender mediation. Cooperation with the court assistance is voluntary for you and there is no disadvantage for refusing.

The legal basis for court assistance can be found in Section 160 III and Section 463d of the Code of Criminal Procedure (StPO) and Section 16 III of the Baden-Württemberg Clemency Code (GnO).

ABOUT US

The Bewährungs- und Gerichtshilfe Baden-Württemberg (BGBW) is a state-run institution under public law. The BGBW's tasks comprise probation assistance, court assistance and victimoffender mediation. It has its headquarters in Stuttgart. There are nine facilities across the state, as well as other outposts and communication stations. This ensures that clients receive support close to home.
