Probation: seize the opportunity!

Your prison sentence or juvenile sentence was suspended by the court. You were placed under the supervision of the probation service. The probation officer will be at your side during this time. He or she has the task of supporting and supervising you.

You now have the chance to prove that you want to lead a crime-free life.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM PROBATION ASSISTANCE:

- Support in fulfilling court orders and instructions.
- Advice and assistance with personal, social and financial problems and in dealing with authorities.
- Information about offers of assistance and, if necessary, referral to counselling centres or therapy facilities.



- Confidentiality towards third parties.
- Support in dealing with your offence (s) and their consequences.

WHAT WE ARE OBLIGED TO DO:

- Report to the court on the progress of your probation and supervision.
- Verify compliance with court orders and instructions.
- Testify in court if legal proceedings are brought against you for a new criminal offence.
- Notify authorities in individual cases.

YOUR PROBATION IS SUCCESSFUL IF:

- You manage to remain unpunished.
- You comply with the court orders and instructions.
- You keep the appointments and agreements with your probation officer.

YOUR PROBATION WILL BE JEOPARDIZED IF YOU:

- Commit a new offence.
- Do not meet the requirements and instructions.
- Do not keep appointments with your probation officer.

In this case, the court can extend your probation period or revoke your probation. Revocation means your imprisonment.



Use the probation period as an opportunity for a fresh start without crime.
