

Victim-offender mediation

Information in plain language.

Victim-offender mediation means:
 Working with the offender and victim without a court of law to reach an agreement.
 Victim-offender mediation is a long word.
 Its short name is: VOM.



The aim of VOM is to reach an agreement between the offender and victim.

A VOM can only be made if both parties agree.

For example:

- An apology
- A compensation payment

The agreement will be written down.


What happens during victim-offender mediation?

There is a mediator.

A mediator is an intermediary.

They are neutral.

They talk to the offender and the victim.



They talk to each of them individually. Then everyone talks together. This is called: A mediation discussion. The mediation discussion is about reaching an agreement. Both offender and victim are allowed to take a lawyer or trusted person in with them.

Opportunities for the victim

- 1. There will be a chance to talk about the crime and the effects it has had.
- 2. The offender takes responsibility and deals with the effects it has had.
- An agreement can be reached.
 For example, a compensation payment.

Opportunities for the offender

- An agreement will be reached outside the court. This means that a conviction can often be avoided.
- 2. The offender can make amends.
- 3. It can lead to a lesser sentence in a court of law.

If there is no agreement, the court must be told. The public prosecutors must also be told. The court and public prosecutors decide what happens next.


